



IMPORTANT NOTE FOR OUR INJECTION PATIENTS

(Prior to your procedure): This *reference sheet* NEEDS TO BE PLACED in an area where it can conveniently be referred to by you, before your procedure. This reference sheet will be your guide and help answer these common questions:

Pre-Closure Patient

What to Do In Preparation for the Closure Procedure

- Discontinue tanning and tanning creams 2 weeks prior to your injection session.
- Bathing can be done the "morning of" the procedure.
- You may eat before the procedure. There are not food intake restrictions associated with this procedure.

What to Do the Day of the Injection Closure Procedure

- Your valium prescription is called in to your pharmacy on file with us; one day prior to your procedure. Have your valium prescription with you. DO NOT take the medication until you are instructed by our staff.
- Bring your prescription compression stockings. They will be needed immediately following your procedure.
- Have a person to be your "driver" after the procedure (if opting to take the valium relaxant).
- You may take Motrin (ibuprofen), or Tylenol (acetaminophen) for any discomfort.

What Prevents Us from Treating You / Proceeding with Your Treatment

- Not bringing your prescription compression stockings.
- Not having a driver (if opting to take the valium relaxant).
